Joy You Cannot Yet See

Sing to the Lord, you his faithful ones, and praise his holy name. For his anger lasts only a moment, but his favor, a lifetime. Weeping may stay overnight, but there is joy in the morning.

-Psalms 30:4-5 (CSB)

1) A Cryptic Comment

a) As if to illustrate what He had just said to His disciples about not being able to handle many of the things He wanted to share with them (John 16:12), Jesus makes veiled comments about His impending death and resurrection which made absolutely no sense before the events actually occurred (John 16:16).

2) Some Confused & Concerned Disciples

- a) Understandably, the disciples are confused by Jesus' comment (John 16:17-18). Similarly to how they had been responding previously (John 16:5ff), the disciples are mostly concerned that Jesus keeps talking about leaving them very, very soon. But they do not understand the timing or it's significance.
- b) Jesus sees and knows that the disciples are confused (there is nothing to indicate Jesus knew what His disciples were thinking by supernatural revelation from God, but rather He probably knew by simply observing them). So, Jesus volunteers (kind of) the answer to their question (John 16:19).

3) I Promise, Joy Is Coming From God!

- a) Jesus shares a parallel explanation to His previous cryptic statement (also equally as confusing to His disciples), but emphasizes that the events about to come would result in their joy (John 16:20). Then, illustrating His illustration which was supposed to explain His first comment, Jesus speaks about the joy of a newborn overwhelming the pain of childbirth (John 16:21).
- b) Then, being a bit more clear regarding what the disciples could expect, Jesus tells them why they will have joy (John 16:22), and that when these events occur it will provide unprecedented availability and access to directly speaking to God the Father in joyous identity with Christ (John 16:23-24).
