# Advent: "Candle of Peace" A Meditation

Today we light the third candle of Advent, the candle of **Peace**.

When we hear the word, "Peace" we shake our heads and wonder if it's even possible. We want peace, but we doubt it will happen anytime soon. Worldly peace seems to be an elusive notion.

In John's gospel Jesus offers a peace that is not like any peace the world knows. Jesus says, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you." Jesus makes this promise as he prepares for his death and return to his Father. "Not as the world gives..." this peace is different.

First, the peace Jesus <u>leaves</u> belongs to him, "MY peace I give you." Think about the depth of that statement! (pause...) "My peace I give you." The very peace that filled Jesus even in the moments before he gave himself on the cross, if available for you!

Second, Jesus says his peace is not like the world's peace. The world's peace is fragile because it is dependent on people agreeing and practicing certain behaviors. His peace is not dependent on circumstances. We don't need to be having a good life or even a good day to have peace. It is dependent on Jesus, what he alone can do. It is dependent on His ability to fulfill the promises already given, and his track record of accomplishment. It is woven into the redemptive work of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. The peace Jesus is offering is the better peace that is durable, because it is built on his eternal nature. It is unfailing because it is tied to his steadfast love.

In Philippians, Paul the apostle calls this peace that Jesus gives, "the peace that passes understanding." From the world's perspective, it doesn't make sense to feel at peace when it looks like things are falling apart. But that is the very essence of the peace from Jesus. It is true peace because it solves the greatest disruption of peace, the sin in our human hearts!

Jesus, the **Prince of Peace** ushers a peace into our hearts that restores our relationships with each other and creation, but more importantly, with our Father in heaven.

Jesus gives us the **best peace**! And it is available for all who believe in him.

This is the peace the world needs.

Father, today as we light this third candle, we give You thanks and praise for the peace that You have offered to us in Your Son Jesus. May we allow this gift of His peace to fill our hearts to full capacity, even to overflow, that we too might become peacemakers, blessed by You and known by the world as Your children.
