# Lavish Love

# 1) The Tremendous Diversity Of 'The Twelve'

- a) Jesus was surrounded by a large crowd of "disciples" throughout His public ministry (Luke 6:17). From this larger group of disciples (Luke 6:13), He chose twelve, and also gave them the name "apostles" (designated representatives sent with the message of their master, much like a government ambassador).
- b) It is important to note that every believer/follower of Jesus Christ is a disciple. But The Twelve were not only Christ's disciples, but also a select group of representatives chosen for training to become Christ's apostles ('Sent Ones').
- c) Retreating to a mountaintop, Jesus spent an entire night in prayer to God (Luke 6:12), and after coming down the mountain He selected The Twelve:

Group #1	Simon Peter, (Always 1st)	Andrew, Peter's brother
	James, Son of Zebedee	John, James' brother
Group #2	Philip (5 <sup>th</sup> )	Bartholomew/Nathanael?
	Thomas, the Twin (Didymus)	Matthew Levi, Tax Collector
Group #3	James, Son of Alphaeus (9th)	Simon, the Zealot
	Judas 'Thaddeus,' Son of James	Judas Iscariot, the Betrayer

d) The Twelve were an incredibly diverse group of men from varied backgrounds from fisherman to a tax collector to a revolutionary zealot. They hailed from different regions around Galilee, and at least one of The Twelve was probably from further South in Judea. They are called The Twelve until Acts 6:2, and from that point forward are only referred to as "apostles," fulfilling their calling in the early church. Judas Iscariot, filled with remorse over betraying Jesus, will commit suicide (Acts 1:18-19). Early church tradition reported that all the disciples were martyred except John, who died of old age at/near Ephesus.

# 2) The End Of Training Draws Near

- a) Triggered by Judas' departure from the Upper Room at the Last Supper (John 13:26-30), Jesus turns His attention to His remaining 11 disciples, revealing that the time has now come for Him to glorify God, and for God to also glorify Himself in Christ Jesus (John 13:31-32). Jesus vividly illuminates that God the Father is glorified (His magnificence is revealed) in the flawless obedience of Jesus the Christ which is now to be further magnified in the crucifixion.
- b) Lamenting the knowledge that He is soon to depart from the time, training, friendship, and deep love He has for His disciples, Jesus tenderly and cautiously tells them that He is going somewhere where they cannot come (John 13:33). He has told this to His enemies before (see John 7:33-34, 8:21), but He has never said this to His disciples whom He has trained intensely for the previous three years.
- c) Filled with love for His disciples, Jesus calls on them to love one another with the same overwhelming love He has displayed to them throughout their time of training. This was especially displayed (earlier that night) in Christ's humble servanthood in stooping down to wash their dirty feet (John 13:3-17).

# 3) The (Kinda) New Commandment To Love

- a) The "newness" of Christ's command to His disciples (John 13:34-35) was not in the idea of loving others, since this is well established in the Old Testament in two timeless commands which fulfill all of the Law of God (Matthew 22:35-40); loving God (Deuteronomy 6:5) and loving others (Leviticus 19:18).
- b) Rather, this is a 'new commandment' for two key reasons. First, the measure of the command is clearly displayed in Christ's training of His Twelve. The measure of love is no longer a lofty philosophical question (what is love?); love is displayed in humble servanthood. It's now "as I have loved you, so love one another." Secondly, the command has a promise. If our hearts and actions are truly motivated by Christ's example of serving one another in love, it reveals Jesus to the world through His ongoing legacy of disciples.
- c) But the disciples are verklempt that Jesus' is departing soon. It seems they hardly hear Christ's "new commandment." Peter, speaking for the heart of Jesus' remaining 11 disciples, promises His fidelity and loyalty. But Jesus knows it is not true, sadly predicting his impending denials (John 13:36-38).
